## Dress Code

- **Business Casual (BC)**

**Women:** A reasonable length skirt (not mini-skirt) or full-length trousers combined with a top (such as a dress shirt, polo, or sweater set). An informal dress with appropriate skirt length is also acceptable. White or black jeans are fine.

**Men:** A combination of collared shirt (such as a dress shirt or polo shirt) and cotton trousers with a belt. A blazer or business jacket can optionally be added.

Unacceptable for either gender: gym clothes rumped or ripped clothing, miniskirts, inappropriately revealing attire such as bare midriffs, and flip-flops.
